

902-875 ROCK CLIMBING TUNNEL INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

IMPORTANT

PLEASE READ THESE INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE BEGINNING ASSEMBLY. It contains important replacement parts information. It is important to use and maintain all public playground equipment properly. ADULT SUPERVISION IS REQUIRED AT ALL TIMES!

GENERAL MAINTENANCE INSTRUCTIONS:

Check MONTHLY for loose bolts, damaged or broken parts. Tighten and/or replace immediately. Replace any parts the show a reduction of 25% from original size.

SHOULD A COMPONENT BECOME DAMAGED YOU MUST CLOSE THE UNIT TO PLAY UNTIL THE REPAIRS ARE MADE!

In order to prevent injury to personnel and damage to components a minimum or two people are required to lift all panels.

To prevent damage to compenents during install all components should be placed on a protective surface (cardboard, plastic sheet or tarp) and not placed directly on the ground while they are being sorted.

EACH ROCK IS INSTALLED IN A CERTAIN LOCATION ON THE PANEL. VIEW THE ROCK LAYOUT PAGE AT THE END OF THESE INSTRUCTIONS FOR PROPER PLACEMENT.

Each hardware box has 2 sets of rocks, one set of rocks is required for each side.

THIS UNIT IS DESIGNED FOR 12" OF LOOSE FILL SURFACING.





SPECIFIC ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS


- 1. Begin by digging 6 holes 10" in diameter and 12" deep based off of the dimensions on the side view footing page at the back of these instructions.
- 2. Install the legs in the holes by filling the holes with 10" of concrete.
- 3. Attach the side panels to the legs with one sloped end of the panel pointing to the left on one side of the structure and he other sloped end pointing to the right on the other side of the structure by using the 5/16x1 3/4 Buttonhead bolt and 5/16 washer on the front side of the panel and by using the 3/8 washer and 5/16x1 Buttonhead nut on the back side of the panel. (view detail drawing on the first page)
- 4. Attach the top panel as shown using the 5/16x1 ³/₄ Buttonhead bolts and 5/16 washers on the top side of the panel and 5/16x1 Buttonhead nut and 3/8 washer on the bottom side of the panel.
- 5. Attach the rocks to the panels using the 5/16x3/4 Buttonhead bolt in the large hole on the front of the rock and the 1/4x1 Buttonhead bolt in the small hole on the front of the rock and the 5/16x1 Buttonhead nut with the 3/8 washer in the large hole on the back side of the panel and the ½ tee nut in the small hole on the back side of the panel. ROCKS MUST BE PLACED ON PANELS IN CERTAIN ORDER. Refer to the following rock layout page to determine which rocks should go were.

6. Install middle support bracket along edge of top plastic piece. Place directly between support legs on the under side of plastic, mark and drill holes, then attach bracket using (2) 3/8" x 1" bolts with 3/8" washers on top side and (2) 3/8" t-nuts on bottoms side.












Top View Footing Layout
